## ***TAKING THE GED TEST***

### **When is the GED Test given?**

The GED Test is generally given the first Monday of each month.

### **Where is the GED Test given?**

*Room 3 of the West View Family Center, located at the corner of 9<sup>th</sup> Street and Main Street, Hamilton*

- The West View Family Center is the old West View Junior High School building, located across the street from the Montana National Guard building (where the tank is!).

### **What do I bring to the GED Test?**

- You must bring \$55. Cash (*exact change only*), personal checks, and money orders are all accepted.
  - You must bring a current, government-issue picture ID. You must be able to prove Montana residency.
  - If you are 17 or 18, you must bring official documentation showing you are not enrolled in public school.
  - If you are 16, you must have already secured your official test waiver from the state.

### **What time do I have to be at the test center?**

If you are taking all five subject tests the same day, you need to be at the testing center by 7:30 AM.

If you are NOT taking all five subject tests the same day, you will be told during preregistration when you need to arrive at the test center.

### **In what order are the GED Subject Tests given?**

*The five GED Subject Tests are always given in the same order:*

#### **From 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM**

Writing - 120 minutes

Part I: 50 questions, 75 minutes

Part II: Essay, 45 minutes

Math - 90 minutes

Part I: 25 questions, calculator allowed (provided by test center)

Part II: 25 questions, no calculator allowed

#### **Lunch Break from 12:00 to 1:00 PM**

#### **From 1:00 to 5:00 PM**

Science - 50 questions, 80 minutes

Social Studies - 50 questions, 70 minutes

Reading - 40 questions, 65 minutes

*Note: You may leave the test center as soon as you have completed the test(s) you have registered to take.*
